INFORMATION LETTER

The Organizing Committee of the XI International Russian-Kazakh Scientific and Practical Conference "Chemical Technologies of Functional Materials" invites researchers, students, postgraduates, and young scientists to participate in the Conference, which will be held in a mixed format (traditional and online) on **May 15–17, 2025**, at Novosibirsk State Technical University. The Conference is organized by Novosibirsk State Technical University, the Institute of Solid State Chemistry and Mechanochemistry of the Siberian Branch of the Russian Academy of Sciences, Novosibirsk, Russia, and Al-Farabi Kazakh National University, Almaty, Kazakhstan.

The main topics of the Conference:

1. Scientific foundations for the synthesis of functional materials. Innovative processes for synthesis, modification, and fabrication;
2. Investigation of functional materials' properties and their practical applications, including environmental considerations in their production;
3. Exploration of processes and equipment in chemical technologies;
4. Comprehensive approaches to studying catalysts and catalytic processes in petro chemistry and oil refining, emphasizing resource-efficient technologies for carbon-containing material processing.

The conference program will include plenary and keynote presentations by leading specialists in the synthesis and chemical technologies of functional materials from research and educational institutions of Russia, Kazakhstan, and other countries.

A competition for the best presentations by students, postgraduates, and young scientists will be held as part of the conference. A collection of conference materials will be published and indexed in the Russian Science Citation Index database.

1. Abstracts formatted according to the specified requirements;
2. A statement confirming the possibility of open publication, certifying the absence of information constituting state or commercial secrets (for Russian participants).;
3. A copy of the document on payment of the organizational fee;
4. Registration Form.

FORMATING THE ABSTRACT

The abstract should not exceed two A5 size pages. A5 format, including figures and tables placed in the text by mention.

Text formatting: 20 mm margins on all sides, single spacing without hyphens, extra spaces, Times New Roman font, 10 font size. Abbreviations used in the text are deciphered upon first use.

The text of the report materials is formatted according to the following requirements:

- title of the report (in capital letters); bold font, 12 font size, centered in the document, without paragraph indentation;
- space;
- information about the authors, which contains:
 - full names of the authors in the following sequence
 - last name, initials; – place of work/study (in full, without using abbreviations);
 - full name of the supervisor (for undergraduate and graduate students);
 - e-mail of the speaker. Bold font (for full name), regular font (for other data), 10 font size, centered in the document, without paragraph indentation;
- space;
- text of materials. Regular font, 10 font size, single spacing without hyphenation, extra spaces, paragraph indentation – 0.7 cm. References to figures – Fig. 1; to tables – Table 1;
- Bibliography (if any, but no more than 5 sources) is compiled in the order of the first mention of the sources. In the text, the source number is enclosed in square brackets.

Formation of the bibliography.

Heading "Bibliography" – bold font, 10 font size, centered in the document, without paragraph indentation; hereinafter referred to as the list: regular font, 9 font size, without paragraph indentation. The list of references is formatted in accordance with GOST R 7.0.5-2008 "Bibliographic entry. Bibliographic description".

Design of figures, tables and formulas in the text of the article:

- figure files in jpg or tif format are placed in the text. Inscriptions and other designations on graphs and figures should be clear and easy to read (normal font, font size not less than 8 in real size);
- design of figure and table captions:

Table 1. Title There are no periods after the title. Normal font, font size 9, text alignment along the left edge of the document, without paragraph indentation.

- Formulas are typed in the MathType editor (Equation Editor), default setting.

The file name should contain the author's last name and initials, for example, Ivanov_AA.docx or Ivanov_AA.doc. The file must be created using MS Word versions 2007, 2010.
